Submission Information

In line with the scope of ACM TKDD, we welcome papers that lay theoretical foundations, papers that provide new insights into the design and implementation of data mining tools, and those that describe user and data mining developer experiences and issues in real-world applications.

Submitted manuscripts will be reviewed following the same model and rigor as TKDD's regular track, except that the guest editors will be in charge of assigning reviewers and the decisions. Submissions will be judged primarily on originality and relevance, but effective presentation is also critical.

All submitted manuscripts must be written in English and may contain only original work that has not been published by, or currently under review at any other journal, conference, symposium, or workshop.

The only allowed exception are "major value-added extensions" of papers previously published or currently under review. A submission that is based on one or more such manuscripts should consist of at least 30% new material; the new material should contain substantial novel contributions, which are explicitly stated both in the cover letter and the Introduction of the submission.
